Canvas is currently experiencing an issue displaying grades on the parent Grade Summary Page, which parents navigate to by clicking Grades on the menu on the left. While the toggle on the summary page is correctly indicating Quarter 3 or Semester 2, the course score displayed on the page is averaging the full year of assignments instead of just the quarter / semester. Parents can see the correct grade by clicking the course name to view the detailed grading page. Our Canvas vendor is aware of the issue, and working on a fix. We will continue to monitor the situation, and anticipate resolution very soon. Students and teachers are not impacted by this issue, and see the correct course scores. The Canvas Student and Parent mobile apps are also unaffected.
