## Family File Information

Parents/Guardians, we have several families who have not completed their student's Family File information. Important information **must** be reviewed/updated for each child and for each year regardless if there are any changes or not. HCPSS utilizes <u>Family File</u> for parents/guardians to complete information and share preferences. Log into <u>HCPSS Connect</u>, select the Family File tab then click on Family File. Once logged in, parents/guardians will be asked to provide or update your student's information.

#### Visitor Procedures

We welcome parents and guardians in to our school building, however it is important that all visitors come in through the front door and sign in at the Front Office. This includes before and after school. Once you have signed in, we can help you get to where you need to go. Thank you for your understanding and helping us to keep our students and staff safe! If you are picking up your child for an early dismissal, please remember that a photo i.d. is required from all parents/guardians for releasing of your student.

Parents who are participating in non-HCPSS sponsored events after school, we ask that you kindly wait outside the school until after student dismissal time so that we may reduce the flow of traffic in our Front Office.

### LKMS' Attendance Reporting Procedures

Parents and Guardians may send notes for absences via email

to LKMSAttendance@hcpss.org. This mailbox will be monitored during school hours for the purpose of receiving absence notes from home; parents providing physician's notes, late arrival and early dismissal notes. Your child may also bring the notes to school too and deliver them to Ms. Hill in Student Services. The school must receive a note from the parent or physician explaining the absence/tardiness of a student within two school days of the student's return or the absence/tardiness will be unlawful/unexcused. Note: Parents are automatically opted in to receiving email notifications when students are marked absent or tardy, however, you may opt out when you complete the Family File. If you would like to opt out, you may edit the Family File through HCPSS Connect. Also, it is important to know that your child will be marked accordingly if they leave for an early dismissal, even when planning to return. At the time your child returns to school, their attendance will be updated, however, the system does not send notification emails for attendance corrections.
