Federal Impact Aid Survey Forms: Federal Impact Aid Survey Forms were distributed to all students. Students who are enrolled as of September 20, 2016 are eligible for the survey. Parents or guardians of students who work on federally owned property in the State of Maryland or who are serving as active military anywhere in the world are encouraged to complete the survey. HCPSS is eligible to receive federal funds based on the number of surveys returned. Submission deadline is December 2. Please have your child give the forms to their homeroom teacher and make sure you sign them! Thank you.
