FROM THE ADMINISTRATION..." Everything you always wanted to know about HOMEWORK...but were afraid to ask!"

I have recently received several questions from parents regarding the appropriate amount and type of homework to expect for their students. This question is not an easy one to answer, as there is not a "one size fits all" response. While homework can be one of several factors that contribute to student success and academic achievement, there is actually very little research evidence linking homework directly to achievement. That being said, there <u>is</u> a place for *QUALITY* homework assignments. Simply put, when it

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comes to homework it is QUALITY over QUANTITY.

So, what is a *QUALITY* homework assignment? Quality homework assignments are those that reinforce or extend classroom learning, are relevant to the real world, and are purposeful. Often, this can be accomplished with a simple written assignment or several math problems. With this in mind, homework might not be assigned for each of your child's classes each and every day. When evaluating your child's homework, be less concerned with the amount of homework in total (*QUANTITY*) and more with the *QUALITY* of the assignment.

Here's a fun homework assignment for you from me...this weekend, spend time together as a family. Get out and enjoy this beautiful fall weather, be active, read, play games, or participate in some community service. I think this is definitely a *QUALITY* homework assignment we can all buy in to!
