Black History Month Presentation by Dr. Robert Harris

In recognition of Black History Month, the LKMS PTA is proud to announce a special presentation by Dr. Robert L. Harris Jr. for the students at Lime Kiln Middle School. Dr. Harris has lived a life dedicated to the scholarly examination of African-American history and worldwide human rights. He is a Professor Emeritus of African American History, American Studies, and Public Affairs, and Vice Provost Emeritus of Cornell University. Dr. Harris has also served as Director of the Africana Studies and Research Center at Cornell University and as President of the Association for the Study of Afro-American Life and History (ASALH), which is the organization that founded Black History Month.

Dr. Harris is the author of Teaching African-American History 3rd Edition, The History of Alpha Phi Alpha: A Tradition of Leadership and Service, and co-author with Rosalyn Terborg-Penn of The Columbia Guide to African American History Since 1939. Dr. Harris currently serves as National Historian for Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. and as National Advisor to the Dorothy Cotton Institute.

We are incredibly honored to have someone so integral to recognizing the important contributions of African-Americans as a member of our community. We are grateful to Leslie Alexander for making us aware of this amazing opportunity and to Dr. Harris for making the time to engage with our students because it will likely be an experience that they won't soon forget.




