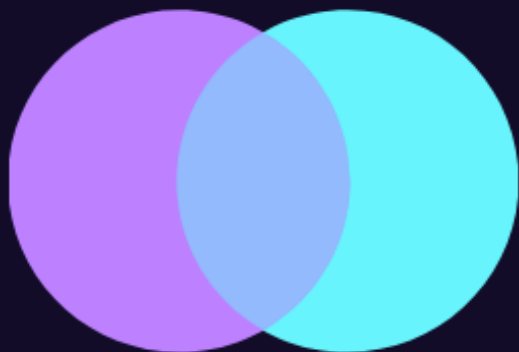


Celebrating the Lunar New Year at LKMS



With the help of some generous parents and students, the PTA decorated the school and provided some festive snacks for our teachers and staff!





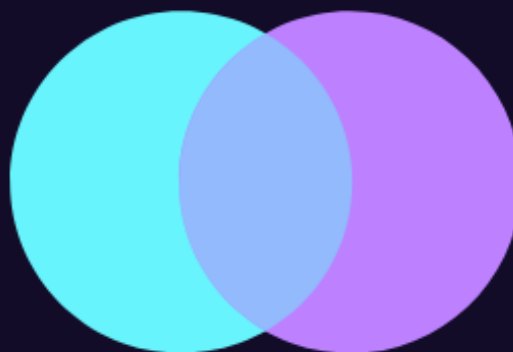

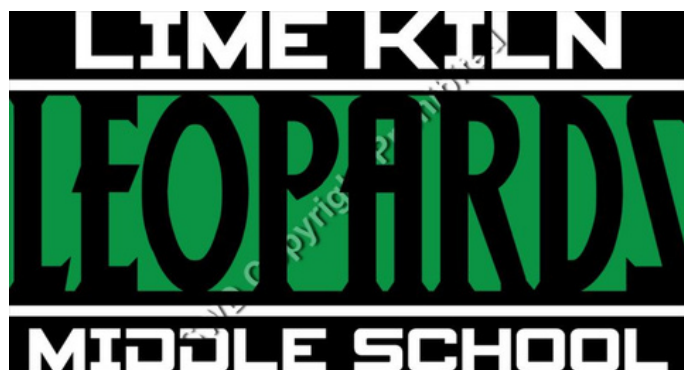

FREE Parenting Classes: Raising preteens and teens is tough. Wouldn't it be great if adults could take a class that taught us how to help our kids avoid risky behaviors, all while learning how to say no to drugs and alcohol? There is! Guiding Good Choices is an evidence-based, interactive prevention program that provides families with the skills and knowledge to reduce the risk that their children will use drugs and alcohol or engage in other dangerous behaviors.

HC DrugFree is pleased to present this popular parenting class for Howard County parents, guardians, and grandparents starting **February 2. This program will meet via Zoom for 5 classes (February 2, 9, 16, 23, and March 2) from 10:30 a.m. to noon.**

Adults should plan to attend all 5 sessions. Topics include

1. How to Prevent Drug Use in Your Family,
2. How to Develop Healthy Beliefs and Clear Standards,
3. Avoiding Trouble: How to Say No to Drugs,
4. Managing Conflict: How to Control and Express Your Anger Constructively,
5. How to Strengthening Family Bonds.
